An outline to help you organize your project, and a final document to submit, wrapped all in one!

This year, the Summer of Innovation is presenting a new tool, the Entrepreneurial Brainstorm Map. This document is meant to be a guide that helps outline all the elements needed for a successful Summer of Innovation submission.

Below is a list of these elements that each Summer of Innovation participant should fill out in their own Google Slide document:

TITLE + SLOGAN SLIDE

What is the name of your project? Here you can establish the theme—fonts, colors, and pictures—that best represent your idea.

INTRODUCTORY SLIDE

Basic information so we know who you are, such as your name, your grade, and what state you are from. Be sure to include a picture yourself.

PRODUCT/SERVICE DESCRIPTION SLIDE

Re-introduces the official name of your product or slogan, but also adds in the paragraph summary that succinctly describes what you've made.

ADDITIONAL PROJECT DETAILS SLIDE

Describes in detail the finer details of the product or service you have created, as outlined in the Summer of Innovation (SOI) Playbook.

IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION SLIDE

Outlines all the formal information that matches your registration form, so we are able to match this presentation with with the info submitted.



ADDITIONAL PROJECT DETAILS

- What is the problem you are trying to solve?
 - Homelessness are more at risk during the pandemic to get COVID-19
- What's your solution? How and why did you come up with the idea?
 - To provide the Homeless during the pandemic with:
 - Team Safety Shirt
 - Antibacterial wipes / safety sanitizer
 - Masks and Gloves
- What is the name of your product or service?What is the slogan?
 - SafetyBox
 - "During these times, it's time to be safe"
- How would you market this product or service to your target audience?
 - By working with nonprofits and homeless shelters

- Who is the target audience?
 - The Homeless
- Explain the materials used, the functionality, etc., for your prototype.
 - Solar Sanitizer Machine to allow homeless to sanitize masks and gloves, using a mini water machine, a solar powered machine powers the machine
- How much does your product or service cost to produce? (materials, labor, etc.)
 - \$20 for workers to assemble the boxes
- What is the sale price of your product or service?
 - \$5 per box
- What is the return on your investment? Or what is your profit?
 - Social and human capital. It will be paid for via donations and government grants.



At the Middle School Level we have Liam from California who created the TikoTank—a self-cleaning, automated-food-giving, and temperature-monitoring fish tank. TikoTank helps mitigate the challenges of raising a pet fish by leveraging technology, while also bringing attention to ocean and aquarium conservation efforts.

"Spreading Smiles"

At the High School Level we have Sophia from Missouri who created Spreading Smiles—a campaign designed to prompt conversations around cleft conditions through t-shirts using innovative and eye-catching designs. Ultimately, the goal is to promote awareness and acceptance for children who are born with cleft lip and palate conditions in order to combat bullying, social isolation, and neglect.
